## 2019 Graduation Information

### Graduation Ceremony

**Friday, May 31, 2019**

**8 pm at Wildcat Stadium**

- *In the event of bad weather, a contingency plan will be communicated out to families via Blackboard, district website, and social media sites.*
- *The graduation ceremony can be seen via live broadcast. Access the live broadcast by going to the Whitehouse ISD website at [www.whitehouseisd.org](http://www.whitehouseisd.org).*
- *Because of ample seating, no tickets will be needed for entry.*
- *The gates will be open at 6:00 p.m. Seating is on a first come basis.*
- *Designated handicap parking and seating will be available on both the home and visitor side of the stadium.*
- *Balloons, noisemakers, and signs that would obstruct the view of others or distract from the ceremony will not be allowed in the stadium. Guests will not be allowed to stand at the rails and on the stairs during the ceremony.*
- *Guests will be allowed on the field for pictures after the ceremony ends. Guests with spiked heels will damage the turf and will not be allowed on the field.*

### Graduation Practice

- *Practice will be held the morning of graduation at Wildcat Stadium. Seniors will need to report to the field house no later than 9 am.*
- *Seniors not in attendance will not participate in the graduation ceremony. Seniors must attend the entire practice.*
- *All fines must be paid before graduation practice. Fines can be paid at the Whitehouse High School office through May 30.*

### Graduation Evening

- *We ask that graduating seniors be dropped off at Wildcat Stadium no later than 6:30 p.m. and report to the field house. Only graduating seniors and faculty members will be allowed in the field house.*
- *No personal items will be allowed in the field house.*
- *Once seniors enter the field house, they remain there until the ceremony begins.*

## Graduation Pictures

- *Pictures will be taken of all graduates as you receive your diploma.*
- *You are receiving a form to take home. You may prepay on the day of graduation or you may order pictures online.*

## Graduation Attire

- *Ladies: Wear a dress and dress shoes that are appropriate for the graduation ceremony. Dresses should be an appropriate length. Spiked heels will damage the turf and will not be allowed on the field.*
- *Men: Wear a solid color shirt, slacks (No blue jeans), necktie, and dress shoes. Facial hair should be neatly groomed.*
- *Alterations or designs to your cap or gown will not be allowed.*

## Graduation Expectations

- *High School Graduation is a once in a lifetime event. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves appropriately to make the ceremony a formal and rewarding time for all the graduates and their family and friends. The Whitehouse High School Code of Conduct will be followed during the ceremony.*
- *Students who fail to meet the expectations for the graduation ceremony may be denied participation.*
