Guidelines for School Delays and Cancellations

Dear Parents & Guardians:

This correspondence serves to inform you of general guidelines relative to either the delay or cancellation of school. Student safety will always be our primary concern. ***There will be days when school is in session when roads may be snow covered and the temperature is quite cold.*** It is critical on such days to ensure that your children dress appropriately for the weather and that any and all drivers exercise caution.

Every effort will be made to have the announcement for a delay prior to **5:45 a.m.** on the day of school or, at times, the prior evening. *It may be necessary at times to change from a delay to a cancellation.* In the event that such a change from a delay to a cancellation is required, every effort in that case is made to have the announcement prior to **7:45 a.m.** We encourage all families to continually check our communication sources on days that there may be a question about road conditions or extreme cold.

The Mount Pleasant Area School District uses the Blackboard Connect call system to communicate with families and continually updates the website and Home Access Center with E-Alerts. These forms of contact serve for weather related or non-weather related delays, cancellations or schedule changes.

The Blackboard Connect system uses phone numbers and emergency numbers that you provide to your child's school. If you are not receiving messages or need to update any of your information, please be certain to contact your child's school. Should there be a situation that requires children to be moved to another building or evacuation area, parents will likewise be notified through the call system.
