PSAT test sales will begin on Monday. In order to register for the PSAT, students simply need to go to the ASB office, and pay a 25 dollar fee for the test. The ASB office can accept cash, card or Apple Pay for payment, and will begin accepting test registrations on Monday, September 9. The date for the PSAT will be on Wednesday, October 16 in the Saugus High School gym. We are asking students to check in for the test at 6:45 AM, in order for the proctors to start the test at 7:00 AM. The test lasts between three to four hours in total, and students will be released back to class at the conclusion of the test. Once all students have registered for the PSAT, further information will be sent out about what to bring to the test.
