

Student ID Procedures



Beginning in September 2019, all Ross Academy of Creative & Media Arts students will be required to wear a Ross issued ID card on a lanyard. This process will add an additional safety measure for our students. ID's are important for safety and security. Everyone knows at a glance who is "official" and it is a quick way for emergency personnel who may not be familiar with our students to know who is who in an emergency situation. It helps to identify who belongs where. We want to provide a safe and orderly environment to foster student learning, and the ID badges will assist in the security of everyone on campus.

- Beginning Monday, September 9, 2019, all students will be required to wear a Ross Student ID while they are on campus. The first ID and lanyard are free of charge.
- Students not wearing an ID upon entry, will have their names written down and a temporary ID will be delivered to them during Homeroom. A student not wearing their ID will have one made. The cost of a replacement ID is \$5.
- Students' face must be visible on their ID (no stickers over your face)
- A student will not be required to wear their ID during PE, but must put it back on at the end of the period
- A student playing during lunch will not be required to wear an ID, but must put it back on at the end of lunch.
- Students may choose to change their lanyard as long as it is appropriate.
