District Wide Disaster Drill Info – Oct. 18, 2018

Our District-wide Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Drill will be performed on October 18th. It is vital that all our children know how to respond to any type of disaster. Student and staff safety is the #1 priority for us at Oak Ridge and within the Oak Grove School District. We must be certain that our students are well prepared to respond appropriately when necessary. We also suggest that safety plans also be in place at home. All students will remain calm and are able to react to crisis intelligently when they have had the opportunity to rehearse the correct procedures *before* any type of real disaster! Students will practice ducking and covering in their classroom followed by evacuating the building. The entire drill will take no longer than 30-40 minutes.
