



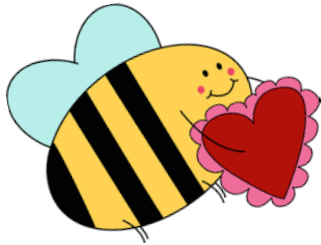
ROADRUNNER REPORT

THIRD AND FOURTH NEWS

Valentine's Day is just around the corner. We are having a party at the end of the day on the 14th. Kids can bring boxes in starting on Monday and valentines on Wednesday Check binders daily and help with their homework if they need it. I can also answer questions in the morning during morning work if they don't understand something. For reading, make sure they are reading at least 20 minutes each night. You can also ask them to retell the story after they have read to help with their comprehension. We are using lots of different computer programs in class to help your child be successful. You can ask them about the programs and they can log on at home to continue working on them.
