Senior Finals June 10 and 11

It is important you prepare for exams and make sure all of your final projects are completed and turned into your teachers as per their instructions. At the end of each day, senior teachers will turn in the names of seniors who have failed. ***Only seniors, who have successfully completed all of their coursework will participate in graduation exercises.***

After completing finals, seniors are to return all books to the bookstore, and clear out their lockers if you have a locker in their name. Graduation Practice June 12

Graduating seniors will meet in the gym to practice for graduation exercises.

10 am: Check-in the North Gym.. Every senior will check in and be seated in the bleachers opposite check in tables. You will learn all about what is expected, and required going through graduation. Also, you will learn about the significance of the ceremony. All **graduating** seniors are required to attend. This is your official record of school attendance for the day. We will practice lining up in the gym, walking out on the field and how to receive your diploma.

11:30 am: Lunch will be served

Once seniors have finished lunch, they are excused for the day. If you did not purchase lunch, you are free to leave after practice. Seniors are not allowed on campus at any time except for the gym, and field while practicing. Seniors will not be allowed to go their lockers, visit with teachers or office staff.

Graduation Day June 13

All seniors must arrive to the North Gym at 12pm to check in. No cell phones, cameras, or noise makers will be allowed on the field. Every senior must have a cap and gown.
