Dear Eighth Grade Parent:

On Wednesday, January 16, 2019, HUHS is hosting the annual GO GIRLS program (Girls Outreach to Girls Investigating Real Life Success). This program began eighteen years ago to promote exposure of 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls to non-traditional career opportunities in areas such as Engineering, Technical Drawing, Construction, Automotive, Graphics, Agricultural Science, and other Trades. The program is supported in part by Quad/Graphics and other local businesses.

HUHS will arrange for your student's transportation to HUHS in conjunction with your school. Students will arrive at the front of the building between 10:30 AM - 10:45 AM on Wednesday, January 16. After registration, students will proceed to café north for lunch. Beverages will be provided, and students must bring their own sack lunches.

The program runs from 11:00 AM until 2:00 PM. The girls spend about 20 minutes in each of 8 stops hearing from teachers and getting to see the facilities. On some of those stops, they will create their own projects. The girls will also be paired with HUHS girls who can answer questions about HUHS, TEE programs, high school life, etc.

Students will be bused back to their schools at the end the program (leaving HUHS at approximately 2:00 PM) for their normal dismissal times.
