Welcome & Introduction

Amy Boles welcomed all parents and thanked them for representing their schools. Amy led the representatives in an icebreaker activity to get to know one another.

DELAC Goals and Outcomes

Amy reviewed the agenda for the meeting. The minutes from the February 7, 2019 meeting were reviewed. Jasmine Hernandez motioned to approve the minutes. Kiran Pundla seconded the motion, all reps present agreed.

EL Master Plan Revisions

The revised Home Language Survey (HLS) Flowchart was reviewed. Amy also shared the program Options flyer and the proposed clarification for the home language survey. Amy explained the changes that were made and asked the reps to review and then talk amongst themselves about the changes and determine if further revisions are necessary. The suggested revisions for the Program Options flyer are: add native Spanish speakers instead of English learners for 1 way and 2 way Bilingual immersion; write school sites at the top of the column where it is offered; add deadlines for applying; add determined/identified through HLS for SEI column under EL; simplify to understand (document is wordy); and offer a bilingual option for students with IEP (speech services). HLS Flowchart revisions: add meaning of EL and IFEP. Home Language Survey (HLS) revisions: add "annual" assessment to the HLS, and add Vietnamese to correspondence Language.

Ideas for Summer Programming: 3 Wishes

Amy asked the reps if they had discussed the 3 wishes/ideas on the summer program at their school sites. Stipe shared that they would like a Spanish based program that includes Science. Hayes said there has not been an ELAC meeting to ask the parents and they are trying to brainstorm ideas for encouraging parent attendance.

Celebration of English Proficiency

Students who have been reclassified in the 2018-19 school year are invited to celebrate on April 18th from 5:15-7:00pm at Bernal Intermediate School with their families. They will receive a certificate that states they have attained English Proficiency. It is a celebration of learning English but also of biliteracy. Amy asked the reps to think of suggestions to improve the event.

STEM Family Survey

Amy shared a link to a survey from the Tech Museum. The purpose is to gather input from families who may face challenges or barriers to participating in family STEM activities. Amy encouraged the reps to share this survey at their school sites so that more parents can participate. Chromebooks were provided for the reps present to take the survey.
