(5th Grade Band) – Instrument, student series vol 1 for their instrument, Standard of Excellence vol. 1 for their instrument; Reeds: Rico #3 for their instruments 4 reeds MUST be in the case at ALL times. Drum Sticks: 5A, 5B, percussion kit; music stand; metronome

(6th Grade Band and 2nd year instrumentalists) – Alfred's vol 1 (for percussion only). All students must have instrument or loan agreement with the school. Reeds (Rico #3 for their instrument) 4 reeds MUST be in the case at ALL times. Drum sticks: 5A, 5B, Vic Firth SD4 Combo (wood tip), set of brushes, yarn and hard rubber mallets for marimba, xylophone

(7-8 Band) - Wind players: Student Series vol 2 (for their instrument); Percussion: Alfred's vol 2 for percussionists, Stick Control and The Art of Bop Drumming; Drum sticks: 5A, 5B, Vic Firth SD4 Combo (wood tip), set of brushes, yarn and hard rubber mallets for marimba, xylophone. All students must have instrument or loan agreement with the school. Reeds (Rico #3 or Van Doren blue box #3 for their instrument). 4 reeds MUST be in the case at ALL times.

(Jazz Band) - Jazz Conception (2nd year members) by Jim Snidero, Easy Jazz Conception (1st year members) by Jim Snidero, Aebersold Vol 1 How to Play Jazz and Improvise, Vol 2 Nothin' But Blues, Vol 3 The II V7 I Progression. All students must have an instrument or loan agreement with the school.

(7th Grade Music) - Folder with lined paper, Pencil, Garage Band or Music Studio Lite on mobile device (if owned by student)
