



ADMISSIONS POLICY

Brookfield is an accelerated school. Prospective students must demonstrate strong academic ability and present a past record of scholastic achievement to be considered for admission. Admission is also based on an assessment of the student's interests, talents, character, enthusiasm for learning, and motivation.

Brookfield School admits students without regard to race, religion, color, national or ethnic origin, sex, or physical handicap to all rights and privileges, programs, and activities available to students.

PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING TO BROOKFIELD SCHOOL

1. Complete the application and return it to the school. Please attach a picture of your child to the application. Apply early if you want consideration for a place at Brookfield. We may not have places available in certain grades, but will maintain a waiting list of qualified applicants. Please give your child's current teacher the teacher recommendation form and a stamped envelope. This form is to be mailed directly to Brookfield School by the teacher.
2. If applicable, attach a copy of your child's standardized test scores for the two prior school years with the application.
3. If you wish to apply for reduced tuition, please request a financial aid packet *before* your child's admissions interview/test. Note the fees for financial aid applicants and be sure that you can agree to the school service requirements in the packet.
4. Make an appointment for an admissions interview/placement test administered by the school principal. New families should note that siblings of current students and children currently enrolled in the Brookfield Preschool are given first priority for available places in the class, but all applicants must qualify for acceptance through the interview/placement test process.
5. Open enrollment for new applicants begins February 16th. New students may be accepted to Brookfield at any time of year, so long as space is available in the class.
6. There is a \$100.00 assessment fee due and payable by check to Brookfield School at the time of your interview/placement test appointment.
7. Some children demonstrate high aptitude and enthusiasm for learning, but may not have the foundational skillsets necessary to enter Brookfield at grade level due to the high expectations and accelerated nature of our program. New students are placed based on performance level and social maturity, and not necessarily on the child's age, birthdate, or previous grade level.
8. If your child is accepted to Brookfield School, a Letter of Acceptance and Reservation Agreement will be mailed to you. Students who are applying during the school year may be invited to come to spend a day or two as our guest at the suggested grade level prior to official acceptance.
9. The student is not enrolled at Brookfield until the Registration Agreement is fully executed, and a \$500 tuition deposit and \$150 registration fee have been received. These fees are non-refundable. The tuition deposit is applied toward the total tuition due for the school year. Late registrations received after the due date indicated on the Letter of Acceptance will incur an increase in tuition of \$1,000 for the year if there is still a place available in the class.
