As you are aware, students are required to take End of Course (EOC) Exams in the areas of Algebra 1, Geometry, English Language Arts(ELA) 1, ELA 2, Biology, American History, and American Government. Below is the list of dates/tests that your student needs to take this winter. If there are any questions or concerns please contact his/her guidance counselor or administration.

There is an “X” by any test that the student needs to take. Please note: the large majority of freshman students will not have any tests to take at this time.

Test makeups outside the testing dates will be offered only to seniors, as it is their last opportunity to take these graduation tests and receive the scores before May. Makeups for other students will be handled on a case-by-case basis, and held during testing, so as to minimize disruptions to instructional time.

In an effort to avoid confusion, please review this testing week information carefully.

- Each testing day will be around 3 hours in length.
- **It is critical that students are well rested and eat a good breakfast before the test.** (*As always, our café will be serving breakfast on these days.*)
- Tested students are expected to get their class assignments from their classroom teachers.
- Junior Auburn students who are testing will not report to Auburn that day. Senior Auburn students are expected to attend if they can.
- All students will eat lunch during the first class of the day. Students will stop in the lunch room to pick up a brown bagged lunch before attending their first class of the day

### AIR Assessment State Testing & Graduation Requirements

All students are now required to take seven end-of-course state assessments throughout their high school career. In order to be eligible for graduation, students must earn a cumulative passing score of 18 points. To ensure that all students are well rounded, students must also earn a minimum of four points in math, four points in English, and six points between Science/Social Studies. Scores will be reported in a 1-5 scale (1 Limited, 2 Basic, 3 Proficient, 4 Accelerated, 5 Advanced). If a student scores limited or basic on any of the tested areas, they will have the opportunity to retest.
