As a child progresses along the road to becoming a teenager, they will experience rapid physical and emotional growth. Your child will need to understand the maturity process, as well as decision making and coping skills, in order to deal responsibly with the various pressures they will encounter. It is important that they develop an appreciation and respect for family life as part of today's culture. In compliance with the Health Framework for California Public Schools, and the California Healthy Youth Act, your child will have lessons which address such issues as growth and development, pregnancy and birth, parenting, abstinence, birth control, decision making, and consequences of sexually transmitted diseases including HIV/AIDS education. The lessons will be taught in two and a half week periods. Please contact your school site for specific dates.

All material presented is age appropriate and taught by your child's teacher. Parents will be notified of any sex education assemblies or guest presenter, which will remain under the supervision of your child's teacher. You have the right to opt your child out of these lessons. An alternative educational activity shall be made available to pupils whose parents/guardians have requested that they not receive these lessons. If you would like to opt your child out of all or portions of these lessons, please indicate this in writing to your school site administrator or child's teacher.
