March 10 – 2:00 to 4:00: "18th Century Weeks of Want" Pickled pork and cornmeal mush! Learn how early Americans ate preserved and dried foods over the winter, described as "weeks of want." The program features preparation of these foods over the museum's open hearth. Museum tours are included. Suggested age: 5 through elementary school. Admission - \$4 13 and older; \$3 3-12; free 2 and younger

March 31 – 2:00 to 4:00: "Maple Sugar Sunday" One of the seasonal tasks of farm life in colonial days was sugar making in the maple woods. The program features a presentation about maple sugaring time on a colonial farm (presentation only; no trees are tapped), open hearth cooking demonstration and museum tours. Admission - \$4.00 for ages 13 and older, \$3.00 for ages 3 to 12 and free under age 3. Suggested age: 5 through elementary school.
