

John S. Gillett Intermediate Dress Code



John S. Gillett Intermediate School implements Standard Attire Dress policy. The district Dress Code FNCA Local is provided to regulate dress during school-designated dress up days, jewelry, body piercing, garments and any other items not covered under the Standard Attire Dress policy. These days will be announced and only at these times will the students be allowed to wear clothes outside the Standard Attire requirements.

The District's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, to prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

BOYS

- Shirts - Short or long sleeve, 5th Grade – RED, 6th Grade - HUNTER GREEN collared polo style shirt (Shirts must be tucked in at all times.) Only white, black and/or gray undershirts will be allowed. Spirit shirts (black/gold with or without Brahma mascot) may be worn every Friday throughout the year.
- Pants – Straight leg Khaki pants with belt loops (No stretch, wide leg, baggy, cargo, carpenter loops, oversized pants, or blue jeans. Pants with pockets on the legs are not allowed.)
- Belt – must be standard fit and worn through loops. All belts must have an appropriate buckle.
- Jackets – Jackets must be standard fit. No oversized jackets or sweaters will be accepted.
- Sweatshirts – Solid sweatshirts with no labels or hoods are allowed. The polo shirt's collar must be worn outside the sweatshirt.
- Hoods will NOT be worn in the building.
- No padded flannel shirts/jackets.
- No shorts.
- Hats, caps, bandannas or headgear shall not be allowed on the school campus.
- No earrings on boys.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times while in school or school functions; the school will not provide Band-Aids or wraps to cover tattoos.

GIRLS

- Shirts - Short or long sleeve, 5th Grade – RED, 6TH Grade - HUNTER GREEN collared polo style shirt (Shirts must be tucked in at all times.) Only white, black and/or gray undershirts will be allowed. Spirit shirts (black/gold with or without Brahma mascot) may be worn every Friday throughout the year.
- Pants – Straight leg Khaki pants with belt loops (No stretch, wide leg, baggy, cargo, carpenter loops, oversized pants, or blue jeans. Pants with pockets on the legs are not allowed.)
- Belt – must be standard fit and worn through loops. All belts must have an appropriate buckle.
- Jackets – Jackets must be standard fit. No oversized jackets or sweaters will be accepted.
- Sweatshirts – Solid sweatshirts with no labels or hoods are allowed. The polo shirt's collar must be worn outside the sweatshirt.
- Hoods will NOT be worn in the building.
- Skirts or Jumpers - Knee-length Khaki skirt or jumper may be worn.
- No padded flannel shirts/jackets.
- No shorts, skorts or capris.
- Hats, caps, bandannas or headgear shall not be allowed on the school campus.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times while in school or school functions; the school will not provide Band-Aids or wraps to cover tattoos.
- Girls may wear one (1) set of earrings on the lobe only.

FOR SAFETY REASONS, ALL FOOTWEAR MUST BE TIED OR SECURED PROPERLY ACROSS THE INSTEP SO THAT THE SHOE DOES NOT “FLOP” OFF AND NO LACES ARE LOOSE.

DISTRICT DRESS CODE (FNCA LOCAL)

- A student's dress, grooming, and appearance may be determined by the student and the student's parents provided the student complies with the following guide lines:
- Garments that are excessively revealing or distracting are considered disruptive and shall NOT be allowed. No oversized pants, sagging pants, dusters or long raincoats.
- See-through shirts or blouses, sleeveless undershirts or vests, cut-off shirts, crop-tops, low-cut blouses, string tie/halter-type blouses or dress, torn clothing are not allowed. Students are NOT permitted to wear garments as outer-wear that are designed as underwear.
- The length of dresses and skirts shall be no shorter than the top of the knee. Split skirts must be knee length.
- Clothes printed or stamped with obscene, vulgar, or suggestive language or scenes are prohibited. Clothes and jewelry printed or stamped with language or scenes depicting sex, death the occult, violence, blood or gore, tobacco, controlled substance or alcohol are likewise prohibited. Jewelry and accessories shall not cause distraction or be dangerous to the individual or others. **No jewelry associated with body piercing will be allowed other than on the ear. All tattoos must be covered.**
- Students shall wear the appropriate footwear at all times. Shoes/boots with steel toes; noise making devices, and shower shoes/thongs are prohibited.
- Sunglasses shall be worn out-of-doors only. Hats, caps, bandannas or headgear shall not be allowed on the school campus.
- Hair shall be kept clean, neat, out of the face, and away from the eyes. The style may not be extreme to the point of creating a danger or distraction. No Mohawk and No Colored hair. Sideburns and mustaches shall be neatly trimmed. The remainder of the face should be clean- shaven. Beards are not permitted.
