CISD CORONAVIROUS INFORMATION

Over the past 24 hours, questions have been raised regarding the District's response to students and staff who may have traveled to cities and states with known Covid-19 (coronavirus) cases, or even to other countries, including those with level 3 travel restrictions.

Throughout this week, we have been participating in conference calls and meetings with both state and local health officials regarding response plans to the coronavirus as well as for guidance on possible closures. In addition, Region 20 school district superintendents will converse on Friday regarding our latest challenges and conditions.

I share this with you to let you know that we are aware of the concerns, as well as the fact that decisions about school closures are not isolated to only Comal ISD, but involve organizations across multiple levels and jurisdictions. In addition, this is not only an unprecedented situation, but one that continues to evolve hour by hour. To that end, we continue to evaluate the information we are receiving and to confer with our state and local health officials on our next steps.

At this time, we anticipate that we will have additional communication for you tomorrow afternoon. However, please know that because of the nature of this situation that we may be sharing information with you sooner, or perhaps have additional information for you over the weekend.

In the meantime, we have set up a dedicated [Covid-19 information webpage](#) that will serve as our clearinghouse for all things related to the coronavirus, including the status of our operations, event cancellations or rescheduling, and health information resources. Please check this page often as we will continually post information regarding any event closures or rescheduling.
