

Chromebooks are Here!

All students in grades K-5 have been issued a Chromebook to be used at school. The Chromebooks are not to go home in younger grades. Older grades may take them home later in the school year, but that will be decided by our administrators. You will be notified before older grades begin taking them home, but this will not happen until the second 9 weeks at the earliest. The students will be issued the Chromebooks at the beginning of the school year and will return them to the media center at the end of the school year or upon leaving the school. The students will be held responsible for damage to the Chromebook that happens while the Chromebook is checked out to them. The Chromebook will follow them throughout their elementary school career. In order to offset costs, parents can purchase insurance. See the back of this sheet for insurance options.

All Chromebooks come with a certain level of coverage when the device is deemed repairable. This will cover such damage as cracked screens, missing keys, internal damage, power surge, and warranty work again within the range of what is deemed repairable.

Students will be responsible for all damage done to the Chromebook that is non-repairable. The entire cost of the Chromebook (\$300) or the repair cost of the device will be due before the student will be issued another Chromebook. For those that cannot pay the entire amount will have the option of a payment plan as long as consistent payments are made. Some situations that are NOT covered are

- theft, burglary, or robbery of Chromebook
- accidental loss of Chromebook
- intentional loss or damage to the Chromebook/charger due to negligence
- illegal use or fraud of the Chromebooks
- dishonest acts including selling the Chromebook
- damage, corrosion, or rust due to liquids or foods coming in contact with the Chromebook
- damage due to changes in humidity or temperature
- insect or animal damage
- any other use the school system deems inappropriate

Students will not be charged for the first two incidents of damage done to the device during the school year the student is enrolled at the particular school. However, after the second incident, students will be charged a deductible fee according to the following scale.

- 1st incident - no fee
- 2nd incident - no fee
- 3rd incident - \$25
- 4th incident - \$50
- 5th incident - \$75
- 6th incident - \$100
- 7th incident - \$300 - complete cost of device
