

– FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS –

What is the Legacy Family eBook Grant? Is this part of the scholarship?

The Alumni Association is pleased to announce a \$125 ebook grant for all incoming Alumni Legacy Family Freshmen. This award is not dependent upon the Legacy Scholarship, it will be provided to all incoming Legacy Family Freshmen. Please indicate on your school application that you are an Alumni Legacy Family.

What is the Alumni Association's Mary Jo Dobler Spirit of La Salle Scholarship? Who is eligible to apply?

The Alumni Association's Mary Jo Dobler Spirit of La Salle Scholarship is a one-time \$1,000 award. Incoming 9th grade students are eligible to apply for the scholarship if at least one parent graduated from La Salle Prep in Milwaukie, OR. This scholarship supports the Alumni Association's mission to provide resources and opportunity for alumni and current students. They also serve as a welcome to our community's newest "Lasallian Legacies."

How many scholarships are awarded?

It is the goal of the Alumni Association to award one \$1,500 Legacy Scholarship for the 2019-2020 school year.

How are the recipients chosen?

Applicants are evaluated based on the following criteria: leadership, academics, service and citizenship. The Alumni Scholarship Committee is also interested in learning about the applicant's goals during their time at La Salle. In order to preserve anonymity and provide for equal consideration for all applicants, all identifying information on the application is omitted prior to review by the Alumni Association Scholarship Committee.

Who makes the decision?

This process is administered by the Director of Alumni Relations. The Alumni Director is a non-voting member of the Scholarship Committee. The Alumni Association Scholarship Committee is comprised of the members of the Alumni Association Board of Directors as well as alumni at-large who are appointed by the Board President. Anyone affiliated with a student applicant is ineligible to serve on the Scholarship Committee.

When is the deadline? Where should I send the application?

All applications must be completed and postmarked no later than Friday, January 18, 2019. All materials should be sent to the following address:
