Anime Club—Biweekly Tuesdays: Watch anime, win CrunchyRoll PRIZES, read manga, learn some Japanese phrases, and EAT!

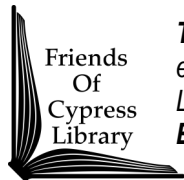
Book Chat Group—*Adults*—"1984" by George Orwell.
