

WORLD LANGUAGE – GRADE 5

CONTENT, SCOPE, AND SEQUENCE

The following themes are interwoven to provide the framework by which students communicate as they explore cultural products, make connections and comparisons, and prepare to participate in local and global communities:

- A. Review and expansion of basic skills and concepts (8-9 weeks)
 - 1. the alphabet
 - 2. colors
 - 3. numbers 0-1,000 (patterns)
 - 4. useful classroom expressions
 - 5. calendar-related vocabulary
 - 6. weather conditions

- B. School (8-9 weeks)
 - 1. faculty members in the school
 - 2. classroom objects
 - 3. introduction of prepositions
 - 4. subjects/specials
 - 5. student schedule
 - 6. maps
 - 7. cardinal points

- C. Daily routines (8-9 weeks)
 - 1. telling time
 - 2. morning/afternoon/night
 - 3. standard/military time
 - 4. typical school day
 - 5. mealtimes

- D. Family (8-9 weeks)
 - 1. extended family members
 - 2. relationships between family members
 - 3. birthdays and age
 - 4. physical appearances
 - 5. personality traits
