PROOF OF RESIDENCY – 2018-19 School Year

“A person who knowingly or willfully presents to any school district any false information regarding residency of a pupil for the purpose of enabling that pupil to attend any school in that district without the payment of a non-resident tuition charge shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.”
(105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b)

This proof of residency form is to attest that the child listed below is not enrolling in the District solely for school purposes and **is living on a permanent basis with the person having complete custody and control**. Registration of a student who is not a resident is a fraudulent act. Any student found to have been fraudulently registered will be dropped from the attendance rolls immediately. Parents or guardians making a fraudulent registration will be subject to the payment of retroactive tuition charged for non-resident students, not to exceed 110% of the per capita cost.

Two types of evidence of proof of current residency must be presented. One from each category:

Category I:

- Most recent property tax bill and proof of payment, e.g. cancelled check for Form 1098
- Mortgage paper (homeowners)
- Signed and dated lease and proof of last month’s payment, e.g. cancelled check or receipts (renters)
- Letter from manager and proof of last month’s payment, e.g. cancelled check or receipt (trailer park residents)
- Letter of resident from landlord in lieu of lease
- Letter of residence to be used when the person seeking to enroll a student is living with a District resident.

Category II:

- Voter registration
- Home/apartment insurance papers and premium payment receipt
- Credit Card bill
- Current Driver’s License
- Receipt for moving van rental
- Mail received at new residences
- Current Receipt for moving van rental
- Vehicle registration
- Current Public Aid Card
- Current library card
- Most recent gas, electric, and/or water bill

Military Personnel Enrolling a Student for the First Time in the District:

Must provide one of the following within 60 days after the date of student’s initial enrollment.

Postmarked mail addressed to military personnel, a lease agreement for occupancy, or proof of ownership of residence.
