Dear Parent and/or Guardian:

Sylmar Charter High School's is committed to preparing all students for the world of work and beyond. Dressing appropriately is part of that preparation. Students are expected to select clothing that is appropriate for the business of learning and not a distraction to the educational environment. All clothing must fit properly covering from the shoulders to the mid-thigh and be neat, clean, and in good repair. All tops must have straps that are at least 2 inches wide. Students may wear Sylmar CHS headgear during non-instructional times.

The following inappropriate clothing is prohibited:

- Clothing or accessories that may indicate gang affiliation; which includes professional athletic teams
- Hats or headgear of any kind, including hairnets and do-rags.
- Midriff backless or strapless tops - No skin should show between tops and skirts, pants or shorts
- Clothing that is sheer and exposes undergarments, or excessive skin
- Bathing suits, tube tops, sports bras, halter tops
- Short skirts and shorts or unhemmed "cut-off" jean shorts
- Clothing or accessories depicting drugs, alcohol, or use of offensive/obscene pictures or language
- Spiked accessories/jewelry

The following Dress Code has been developed with input from students, parents, and staff.

Students not dressed appropriately will have inappropriate clothing confiscated, and given clothes to wear at school that day. Parents will be notified.

Failure to comply with the dress code policy may result in disciplinary measures, loss of student privileges, detention and/or suspension.
