What?	YEAR 13 will provide Columbian graduates with career advising and wrap around support during, and <i>beyond</i> high school.
How?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Contact with a personal advisor● Relationship building through small group and individual encounters● College/career exploration experiences● Continued contact between advisors and graduates in the 13th year to cheer them on, provide college/career advice, answer questions or connect youth with other organizations who will provide additional support● Referral to partners or direct intervention to address any barriers that arise (could include connection with other resources, such as mental health services, Ohio Department of Job & Family Services, Family & Children First Council, addiction recovery services, etc.)
When?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Relationship building activities take place during the 12th grade year● Contact with YEAR 13 advisors, three or more times during the year following graduation
