

## **Assignment:**

### **Criteria:**

- **Any genre that you find interesting.**
- **Try different types of books.**
- **If a book you read has been made into a movie, you cannot use it for assessment.**
- **Take notes for the book that you will write about in September:**
  - **Be able to describe the setting**
  - **Know your characters!**
  - **Be able to write a one-paragraph summary**

**For your Google Classroom Summer Reading assignment, please choose 2 books from all of the books you read to complete a Google Drawing.**

### **Include on the drawing:**

- 1. Title of novel and author's name (Include a link to the author's website, if you find one!)**
- 2. A list of characters from the novel**
- 3. A description of when and where the novel took place**
- 4. 5 adjectives you would use to describe the novel**
- 5. One important quotation (A sentence or two from the novel) - Write the quotation in quotation marks - Include the page number - Next to the quotation, explain why this is important**
- 6. At least 3 symbols and/or images that represent aspects of the story. These aspects could be symbols that represent the characters, setting, or theme in your story.**
