**RE: Summer School 2019**

Below is an overview of the 2019 Proposed Summer School Program.

## Eligibility

- Summer School is open to all students entering Kindergarten - 8th grade and residing within District 96 boundaries
- Children who live in District 96, but do not attend District 96 schools may attend summer school for an additional 20% fee per class
- Skill Building classes are offered only to District 96 students who have been identified as at-risk according to the Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) data

## Program Overview

- Schedule
  - Continue with the four-day week, Monday through Thursday
  - Recommended dates: July 15 - August 8 which avoids the week prior to the start of school
- Course Session Structure
  - Continue Class sessions as 1-week, 2-week and 4-week classes
  - Class length to be **60 minutes, 120 minutes or 180 minutes daily**
    - Note: Classes such as robotics require 120-180 minutes per session daily
  - Maximum **three** classes per day per student
  - Enrichment classes require a minimum enrollment of 6 students per class

- Fee Structure
  - Enrichment
    - 1 hour of class daily = \$35/week
    - 2 hours of class daily = \$70/week
    - 3 hours of class daily = \$105/week
  - Skill Building
    - 1 hour of class daily= \$35 for entire 4-week session
    - 2 hours of class daily = \$70 for entire 4-week session
- Transition to Hauser
  - Continue 1-week sessions to accommodate more students and focus exclusively on transition activities
- Single Campus Model
  - Grades 6-8 will be held at Hauser
  - Grades K- 5 will be held at Central
    - Note: Class requiring handicapped accessibility will be held at Hauser
- Sample Enrichment Classes
  - Robotics
  - Transition to Hauser
  - Coding
  - Creative Writing (Poetry and Prose)
  - Drama & Improv
  - Science Explorers
  - Transition to Kindergarten
- Sample athletic camps
  - Basketball
  - Volleyball
- Timeline
  - Summer School Packet sent out by March 11, 2019
  - Online Registration Begins March 18, 2019 at 8:00 a.m.
