
Dear Creekside Park Junior High Families,

As we continue to elevate all measures in Tomball ISD, we want to ensure you that the safety of our students, teachers, and staff is one of our top priorities. Effective Monday, December 17<sup>th</sup> 2018, the front doors to CPJH will remain locked at all times. You may have already noticed this procedure in place at elementary campuses. Visitors to our campus are asked to ring the doorbell, show identification to the camera and state the purpose of the visit before being admitted into the building. Please report to the front office immediately upon entering the building. Please note that only one visitor will be admitted at a time to prevent visitors entering without being appropriately identified.

When coming to campus, please prepare in advance by having your photo identification ready upon arrival. If you are dropping off your child after 8:00 a.m. (tardy), you must come into the front office with your child. Please do not drop off your child at the locked front doors – they must have an adult with them.

Tomball ISD is committed to creating innovative action plans to help improve school safety and this project is one of many to be implemented. We thank you for helping keep CPJH safe for all students and staff and we look forward to educating your child in a safe and welcoming environment.
