Attendance Office: Dial 214-780 plus extension

Illness: report student absence **by 9am** to the attendance office*. Send a note w/your student to the attendance office the first day back to school.

Leaving School: If a student needs to leave during school, send a note to the attendance office **by 8am**. Failure to send a note causes class disruptions and delays in student leaving the building. Student obtains green dismissal slip from attendance to leave class and the building and meets parent at the student entrance. Parent does not need to come in. Student returns to school through the student entrance and reports to the attendance office to get a pass to return to class. (Without a note, parent should call the attendance office and text student to go to attendance to get green slip.)

Clinic: Students who become ill during the school day should go to the clinic PRIOR to contacting their parent. Please wait for the nurse to contact you before coming to pick up your student.

Community Service Hours: Students are required to have 50 service hours to graduate. Direct questions to Mrs. John (johnb@hpsid.org) or Coach John (johnh@hpsid.org).

Deliveries: All deliveries to students go through the Student Entrance on Westchester. Classes will not be interrupted. Flowers, invitations, gifts, balloons, medicines are not accepted. **Meds go to the Clinic.**

Dress Code: All persons at HPHS should present an appropriate and well-groomed appearance at school. **All final decisions on the appropriateness of school dress will rest with campus administrators.** If a student violates the dress code (see Kiltie), the student will be given the opportunity to correct the problem. If a student cannot correct the problem, the student will be assigned to ISS for the remainder of the day or until the problem is corrected.

Driver's License-VOE forms: (Old TEA) **Verification Of Enrollment** verifies previous semester's attendance. Students request/sign for a VOE form with their assistant principal. Until January, 2019, freshmen and students new to the district must contact their previous school for a VOE. **Forms are good for 30 days.** For summer b-days, forms are available the last week of school and are good until the first day of school in the fall.

Entrance: After 8:10am, students must use the Student Entrance.
