Electronic Devices: (cell phones & earbuds):

- Students will put cell phones and earbuds away, in backpacks or pockets, before they walk into class. If cell phones or earbuds are out, even if not in use, they will be confiscated.

Consequences are as follows

- 1st Offense- Parent must pick up after school
- 2nd Offense- Kept for a week & parent must pick up after school
- 3rd Offense- Kept until the end of the semester & parent must pick up after school

Again, there will be no warnings or exceptions regarding this policy. So please be mindful and keep them in your pocket or backpack throughout class time.

Uniform expectations:

Students will come to school in complete uniform every day, grade level polo. School sweater or approved sweater, socks and shoes. Solid black, white, grey long sleeves underneath polo.

TOPS: Grade level polo shirt (must be a school-issued polo shirt):

- 9th grade hunter green
- 10th grade dark grey
- 11th grade navy blue
- 12th grade burgundy

Outerwear: (jackets and sweaters) may **NOT** have logos larger than a business card, and may only be the following solid colors: **black, white, or grey**. Outerwear may not have markings, designs or logos on the back or arms, or have stripes, etc.

Undershirts, long sleeves, etc. must be solid colored (no stripes or markings) and can only be: **black, white, or grey**.

School uniform sweaters are available for purchase.

BOTTOMS: Black Pants, long skirts, or long shorts. **No leggings, sweats, bottoms with holes or tears.**

SOCKS: Must be solid, plain white or black.

SHOES: Red or blue shoes are **NOT** allowed, this means no lines, laces or designs in red or blue of any shade.

NON UNIFORM EXCEPTIONS: Students are allowed to wear college sweaters or shirts on Wednesdays with uniform bottoms and shoes. They can wear their Eagle Pride or club shirts on Friday, as well, with uniform bottoms and shoes.

NOTES: If students come to school with non-approved uniform clothing articles they will be asked to remove them and will be offered school loaners.

Backpacks, sweaters, chairs on desks

- Students will hang backpacks on the back of their seats at the beginning of each period.
- If chairs are up when students enter the room, students will help to put all the chairs down in class.

Food/drink/gum policy

- No food, gum or drinks allowed in class.
- Plain water in a plastic bottle (reusable, or disposable) is permitted throughout the school day, including in class.

Fast Food / Outside Food Policy

- No fast food is permitted on campus. Students may not bring it to campus, parents may not drop it off, and it may not be delivered by any means (Uber Eats, Postmates, Door Dash, etc). If a student has fast food on campus, he / she will not be permitted to eat it.
- If a student brings homemade food from home he / she can eat it at appropriate times (ie. nutrition, lunch, afterschool), but may not share it with any other students.
- Students are not to bring outside drinks, including, but not limited to soda, Gatorade, Energy Drinks, coffee drinks, etc. onto campus. If they are brought to campus, they will be confiscated.
