This year's class includes Craig Lannom former Junction City teacher and coach. Coach Lannom Was the Head Girls Basketball Coach for 25 years and football Defensive Coordinator for 22 years. His teams appeared in 14 state playoffs finishing 2nd in 1996 and nine times had 20 plus wins in a season and at one point had a 31 game winning streak. Coach Lannom has received numerous recognitions throughout his coaching career.

Bill Carson Graduated in 1956, Bill was a three sport athlete playing football, basketball and baseball. Bill was selected to the All-League First Teams in football and was team captain in football and baseball. He was also a student leader and honor student during his high school career.
