

LEXINGTON THREE ANNOUNCES IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR

Listed below are important dates and information for Lexington Three students and parents concerning the 2018-19 school year.

Thursday, August 16, 2018 – Fee Collection/Schedule Pick-Up/Meet The Teacher Day will be held at each Lexington Three school for K4 through 12th grade students. Fees may be paid and schedules picked up from **11 a.m. until 7 p.m. at each school**. During this time, students and parents are encouraged to also meet teachers and visit classrooms. (This year, we are combining schedule pick-up/fee collection day and parent/teacher orientation. Students/parents are reminded that this is not a parent/teacher conference, so please limit your time speaking to teachers so that all students and parents may have the opportunity to introduce themselves to teachers.)

Please note that parents whose child/children has/have previously been enrolled in a Lexington Three school should register their child/children online this year prior to August 16th. (The August 16th event is solely for the purposes of paying fees, picking up schedules and meeting teachers. However, in the event that a parent cannot register his/her child/children online prior to this date, there will be computer labs set up at each school on August 16th so that parents can do the online registration then.) More detailed information about the online registration process will be forthcoming in a few weeks on the District Three website (www.lex3.org) and in future editions of *The Twin City News*. Students who will be brand new to Lexington County School District Three this upcoming school year are encouraged to visit their respective schools prior to August 16th in order to register in person.
