

Minutes of a Special Meeting of
The Board of Directors of the Madrid Community School District
December 10, 2018

I. Call to Order

The Board of Directors for the Madrid Community School District met for a special meeting on Monday, December 10, 2018 in the Administration Building board room. Meeting was called to order by President Lauren Clark at 6:30pm.

II. Roll Call

Members present included Allie Antonovich, Chelcie Badgley, Lauren Clark, Doug Greufe and Marvin Ostrander. Others present were Superintendent Brian Horn, Board Secretary Kris Van Pelt, 7-12 Principal Kelly Williamson, 7-12 Dean of Students/K-12 AD Justin Johnson, Drew Bracken, School Legal Counsel with Ahlers & Cooney, P.C.; 2 other guests.

III. Closed Session – Iowa Code 21.5(1)(a) and 21.5(1)(e)

Moved by Ostrander to enter closed session as provided in section 21.5(1)(a) to review or discuss records which are required or authorized by state or federal law to be kept confidential or to be kept confidential as a condition for that governmental body's possession or continued receipt of federal funds and section 21.5(1)(e) to discuss whether to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend or expel a student. Antonovich seconded the motion. Roll Call: Badgley, Greufe, Ostrander, Antonovich, Clark. Motion carried 5-0. The board entered closed session at 6:31pm.

Moved by Ostrander to exit Closed Session – Iowa Code 21.5(1)(a) and 21.5(1)(e). Antonovich seconded the motion. Roll call: Greufe, Ostrander, Antonovich, Badgley, Clark. Motion carried 5-0. The board returned to open session at 7:21pm.

IV. Discussion and Action on Student Placement and/or Discipline

Moved by Antonovich that the board uphold the decision of the administration and direct placement of the student at the alternative program with the intention that the student succeed in that placement and return to the regular school as soon as appropriate, depending on the student's progress. Ostrander seconded the motion. Roll call: Ostrander, Antonovich, Badgley, Greufe, Clark. Motion carried 5-0.

There was no further business to come before the Board for consideration at this time. President Clark adjourned the meeting at 7:33pm.
