



The Pettus ISD Board of Trustees is pleased to announce that we have selected Mr. Michael E. Homann as our Lone Finalist for the position of Superintendent.

We retained the services of Walsh, Gallegos, Trevino, Russo and Kyle for this process, posted the position on TexasISD and TASANet, and received an overwhelming response of 29 applications. Dr. Dixon conducted extensive reference checking on behalf of the Board, and individual Board members also did background checks of the applicants as well. The Board reviewed the applications and narrowed them down to five highly qualified individuals who were interviewed by the Board. We were extremely pleased with the quality of all five of the individuals we interviewed; however two persons rose to the top of our list. On Monday, February 18, 2019, the Board conducted final interviews, and we were unanimous in our selection of Mr. Homann.

Mr. Homann's wife is a kindergarten teacher at Medina Valley ISD; he has two sons...one a senior and one a freshman at Medina Valley High School. Mr. Homann comes to us from working as an Assistant Superintendent of Business and Finance in the Medina Valley Independent School District, including Luling ISD prior to going to Medina Valley ISD. The Board members believe that his energy, ideas and passion for educating the students of Pettus ISD will help build on the successes of the District going forward. Mr. Homann spent 10 years of his career as a teacher in the classroom so he understands and can relate to the hard work of the teachers and students.

Mr. Homann cannot be hired as Superintendent until after a 21-day waiting period which is required by state law and the Board anticipates officially hiring him on March 18, 2019, and will begin immediately.
