

- A. 1st meeting of the new 2018-2019 school year, Ms. Lane and Mr. Rhodbeck were speaking during this portion of the meeting.
  - a. Trainings dates will be sent through email for interested members.
  - b. Elections were held before school started
    - i. Dustin Rhodbeck - President
    - ii. Lillian Martin - Vice President/Secretary
  - c. Meeting schedule: Wednesdays at 3pm
  - d. Check information on the member sheet, cell phone and emails will be posted online. Please contact Ken Castagno if you do not want your personal cell phone on the website.
- B. Due by October 20th 2018, as announced by Mr. Rhodebeck
  - a. Names and email addresses of each council member needs to be posted
  - b. Principal assurance form needs to be completed
  - c. Fall final reports of previous year must be completed and entered
- C. Review of last years plan, Ms. Lane spoke about this part of the meeting.
  - a. Field trips : buses/driver, every grade will get one
  - b. New Microphones
    - i. The old mics are kept for students to use during presentation
  - c. Assistant Secretary
    - i. We had a title 9 representative come out and he was impressed how we had her helping with parents because it gave a greater sense of community involvement.
  - d. The budget has been cut by 15,000 for next year. Which is an Paraprofessional/Aide's salary. The teachers were asked if they wanted to cut an aide or cut their after school hours and it was decided that the teachers would have 1 less hour so that all the Aides can be kept.
- D. The new year's plan is due in March/April 2019.
- E. Counselor Corner, Mr. Castagno spoke during this portion of the meeting.
  - a. We will get a report card for the school with no letter grade
  - b. Public information on data gateway on usbe.com from last year
  - c. He will be doing group lunches per the teacher's request to focus on behavior, redirection, and personal growth.
  - d. He is in each class every week
    - i. That week he was doing a lesson on "Reader's Theater" where the older students read to the younger ones.
    - ii. Each week he will do a lesson on life skills such as anti bullying, resiliency, and other character skills.
    - iii. He also will be doing individual meetings after parents sign a form of consent.
  - e. Every school in Tooele County School District gets more counselors expect ours.
    - i. There is a grant in place to pay the extra counselors and the district supplements when necessary
    - ii. All are encouraging coping skills

- f. He is still going to the High school where he meets with 8th grade girls who remember things that happened to them in 3rd grade. They appear to carry it with them and then let it come out in 8th grade and choose to handle those thoughts and feelings then.
      - g. There is an employee assistance plan to call counselors eligible for benefits.
      - h. Ms. Lane explained to us that the Buddy Bench is not necessary anymore because of the painted activities on the playground.
- F. Painted Activities on the Playground, Mr. Castagno and Ms. Lane spoke about this part of the meeting.
  - a. There are kickball games to do alone or with friends
  - b. Going to borrow stencil staves from other schools to paint on our playground.
  - c. Since the paint is in use Ms. Martin mentioned using the paint to repaint the grade numbers in the back and front where the kids line up to make it easier for everyone to see.
- G. Pick up In the Back, Mr. Rhodebeck spoke about this portion of the meeting
  - a. Someone thought it was a firelane and called the district, the district called and told Ms. Lane to let the kids be picked up in the front.
  - b. It was a cluster in the front and more of a hazard
  - c. An inspector came out to see the pick up in the front
  - d. We continue to have pick up in the back because it is safer for the parents and students
  - e. The bus almost hit a car while the bus was trying to leave
  - f. The city of Wendover doesn't provide school zone signs, painted lines, nor a crossing guard.
  - g. There are 2 hydrants in the back
  - h. If there was a fire we would have to keep all the kids and go to the Catholic church
- H. Trainings on YouTube, Ms. Lane and Mr. Castagno spoke about this portion.
  - a. Ms. Lane, Mr. Castagno, and Mr. Salens want to make a tutorial for SIS.
    - i. The parents would watch this to help navigate the site
    - ii. This would be presented at parent night
- I. Parent Night, Mr. Castagno and Ms. Lane spoke about this portion.
  - a. The theme will be safety themed "Safe UT"
  - b. Technology based for parents to be informed on how to track or limit cell phone use.
- J. Bus, Mr. Rhodebeck spoke about this portion.
  - a. Having the aides on the bus helps keeps the students in their seats and not standing when the bus is going.
  - b. Bus rules need to be signed by each parent and student so that when they do not follow the rules they can be kicked off the bus temporarily.
  - c. The rules will be posted on the bus such as
    - i. No climbing over seats
    - ii. Sit until the bus stops.

- iii. Leave the windows opened half way
- iv. 2nd bus kids need to wait until the 2nd bus to cross the street in certain areas.
