On **Monday, January 21st** you will receive an email or SMS invitation to join our **Pleasanton ISD** exclusive phone app called Sangha. This new app will replace the current PISD App you had previously downloaded, please remove this app from your device as it will no longer be updated.

The new app, Sangha, will enable you to remain updated while on the go. Teachers will soon be sending announcements, adding calendar events, sign-up request, and schedule parent teacher meetings through Sangha. Sangha will assist campus and district communication and engagement with parents and families. The app will allow expedited information without having to wait on a paper copy.

Your email invitation from Sangha will arrive in your inbox on **January 21st** and include the title "Invite from Pleasanton (students campus)" or you might receive a text message with a link. You will be asked to register, create a password, and download the app (iOS or Android). For security reasons, your invitation is directly tied to your email address or phone number; therefore, you cannot forward it to someone else. This message will be sent to the student's primary contact. If you need to update this information, please contact the campus office of the school where your child attends.

We will also have a parent informational and technical session on January 24th at 6:30 at the District Training Center.
