### Results

The Hampton School District One Board of Trustees took the following action at the November 24, 2014 Board meeting:

- 1) Approved the minutes of the October 27, 2014 and the November 13, 2014 meetings as presented.
- 2) Approved a General Obligation Bond in the amount of \$70,000.
- 3) Approved an overnight field trip for the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students at Brunson Elementary School to go to Barrier Island February 11-13, 2015.
- 4) Approved an overnight field trip for the North District Middle School Junior Beta Club to attend the SC State Convention in Myrtle Beach January 14-16, 2015.
- 5) Approved the recommendation to grant the diplomas to those former students that failed to receive diplomas solely because of the lack of an acceptable HSAP score.
- 6) Expelled student #1 for the remainder of the 2014-2015 school year.

#### Board Listens

Mrs. Murdaugh called the meeting to order and Rev. R. P. Hodge gave the invocation.

### **Superintendent's Report**

Dr. McTeer is exploring the possibility of making Varnville Elementary a Pre-K through First grade school, and making Ben Hazel a Second and Third grade school.
