To All Park City Prep Families:

I am sure that you are all aware that food allergies are a growing concern in schools across America. For some of our students and staff, any exposure to peanuts/nuts may cause a life-threatening, allergic reaction that requires emergency medical treatment.

To reduce the chance of this occurring, **we are asking that you do not send any peanut, other nuts or nut containing products to school with your child.** *Given the potential serious consequences that could occur if others are exposed to nuts, any student who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action.*

We appreciate your support in helping us to implement this most important policy. It is our intention to ensure the safety and well-being of all our students and staff and know that you will understand and respect our concern and decision in this matter.

If you have any additional questions or need any further information regarding this matter, please do not hesitate to contact our school nurse Dianne Johnson at extension 36.

In addition, we have found some students bringing Tylenol and other over-the-counter medications to school. Please be aware that **we cannot permit students to self-administer any medication without official doctors' orders.** If your child needs to take any such medication from time to time, send it to our nurse with the doctors' orders and we will see that your child gets what he or she needs.
