Application, 3 letters of recommendation, an activities resume, a personal statement, and a copy of your transcript

★ Where do I turn it in?

To the College and Career Center

## ML Local Scholarships Common Application 2017-2018

*Please read the application checklist and the eligibility criteria thoroughly and apply for the scholarships you are eligible for. All checklist items must be included. Sponsors will not accept incomplete applications.*

*Some scholarship sponsors will conduct interviews so make sure you know a little about the organizations.*

### Application checklist:

**Application**

**Personal statement**

- Personal statement should include your educational/career goals & objectives. Describe honors you have received from school or out-of-school activities including positions held, recognitions, etc. Also, emphasize the service work you have done for your school, church or community. Explain why you wish to continue to a post-secondary school and why you have chosen the field you indicated. Include a financial need statement and any unusual circumstances. Personal statement does not need to be limited to these items, tell your story.

**Activities resume**

**3 letters of recommendation** (1 from the school, 1 from a source not connected to the school, & 1 of your choice)

**Copy of current transcript** (request online [www.mlhs.mlsl161.org](http://www.mlhs.mlsl161.org))

**Deadline: February 28, 2018 by 4:00pm**
