**REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING**

The Alcoa City Schools' Board of Education held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, November 18, 2014, in the Harry B. "Mickey" McClurg Board Room at the Alcoa City Schools' Education Building. On roll call, the following officials were present: Board Members: Steve Marsh, Chairman, presiding; Johnelle Jackson, Vice Chairman; Harry B. McClurg, Julie Rochelle, Charles Cameron, Director of Schools and Secretary to Board, Brian Bell; Recorder, Gennie Cardwell; and fifty four (54) visitors, when the following proceedings were conducted.

Board Chairman Marsh called the meeting to order. The audience participated in a moment of silence and the pledge of allegiance.

Board Chairman Marsh asked for comments from the audience. Sharon Howard expressed appreciation to the Board for the purchase of the new bus for special education students.

Dr. Brian Bell, Director of Schools, recommended that the Board approve the minutes of the October 21, 2014, Regular Board Meeting and Financial Reports for September, 2014. Motion was made by Board Member Jackson and duly seconded by Board Member Rochelle to approve the above named consent item. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Dr. Bell presented a representative from each school who gave an update of activities for their individual school. The Alcoa High School Boy's and Girl's cross country teams were presented to the Board and congratulated on their recent qualification and participation in the State Cross Country Meet. Austin Atchley, an Alcoa High School Freshman and Tech Team Member, was also recognized for his hard work on the Football Jumbotron.

Dr. Bell presented the Monthly Personnel Report.

Dr. Bell presented Mr. Barry Brooke, of Lawler-Wood, who updated the Board on the new high school project and presented them with a written copy of the monthly update.

Dr. Bell recommended the approval of Dual Enrollment for the Elective Focus Program of Study at Alcoa High School. Motion was made by Board Member McClurg and duly seconded by Board Member Cameron to approve Dual Enrollment for the Elective Focus Program of Study. After general discussion the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Dr. Bell recommended the approval of Tennessee State Board of Education High School policy allowing students to complete an additional ½ credit in Physical Education by other means. Motion was made by Board Member Cameron and duly seconded by Board Member Jackson to approve the policy allowing students to complete an additional ½ credit in Physical Education by other means. After general discussion the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Dr. Bell updated the Board on upcoming events listed in the Board packet and the Board set the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the new Alcoa High School to take place July 20, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.

Board Chairman Marsh thanked everyone for attending the meeting. With no other business the meeting was adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
