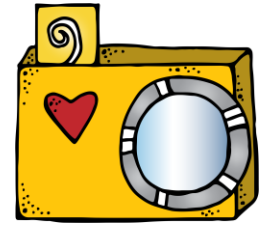


Photo Editing Project Assignment Sheet



- You will be using Pixlr to create a re-imaged photo that will be graded and taken for a major grade.
- Your new photo will consist of 4 parts . . .
 1. **Picture background** (you can Google for one, but it can't be copyrighted, cartoon, or a game and there can be NO WATERMARK on the picture)
 2. **Layer with you** (you must be a main part of the final picture, so you are going to need a picture of yourself for this project)
 3. & 4. **2 Props** (items that you will edit & remove the background and place in the picture with you)
- Your new photo must show action! It should tell a story!
- Your final photo should look like a REAL PHOTOGRAPH taken with a camera, that's how good your cutting out of items must be.
- The 2 props that must be in your picture cannot have a transparent background already. You can have additional props that have transparent backgrounds, but they WILL NOT COUNT towards your requirements for the project. You must remove the background of 2 props to put in your picture.
- If you use a prop more than once, it will only count as one prop.
- No copyrighted backgrounds with watermarks are allowed. Your backgrounds should be at least 800x600 in size but 1000X800 would be ideal. Larger images can be edited - smaller images are unacceptable.
- No copyrighted props with watermarks are allowed.
- 2 props is the MINIMUM requirement. If you would like higher than a minimum passing grade (75), you should do additional props to add credit (see Grading Rubric for additional information).
