WEB SURVEY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Students must log in to their AUSD Google accounts using their student ID's and password.
2. Once logged in, the student can access the survey by going to the following web address: <http://www.ausd.us/climate/>
3. The survey contains several sections, and participants mark their responses.
4. Survey results will automatically populate in our linked spreadsheet — no further action required by proctors.

Notes:

- Information regarding the climate survey has been posted on both AUSD and GTS websites notifying parents, per legal requirements. The survey is voluntary and confidential. Any personally identifiable information will not be in the results. We collect it to ensure we have only one response per student. If you have any concerns with your parents, please refer them to our office.
- Some of the survey questions cover controversial topics that can lead to students disclosing sensitive information. Please be mindful of how you approach the concerns that arise and please refer students to Gateway services as needed.



SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY *2018-2019*

In recognition of the importance of school climate, the Alhambra Unified School District (AUSD) developed an annual survey to assess the perception of school climate among students. This survey is of utmost importance to the district, as it is required under the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). The LCAP describes the goals and specific actions to achieve those goals for all pupils, and the survey is just one of the many ways to identify student needs.

The Annual Student Climate Survey is being administered from March 18, 2019 through March 22, 2019 to randomly selected classrooms grade 4 through 12 at each of our schools in the form of a Google Document. The survey provides students with an opportunity to communicate their perceptions about their learning environment, school safety and student engagement, etc. The survey responses are anonymous. The survey is voluntary.
