The Port Arthur Independent School District has worked actively on a plan to provide meaningful instruction in the event schools were to close due to COVID-19 (Coronavirus). As you may be aware, with the growing uncertainty surrounding these circumstances, the District has made the decision to plan for an extended closure.

The District's Curriculum staff has planned lessons using resources that will support learning at home in order to avoid achievement gaps upon return to school. Accommodations for students with disabilities are embedded in the resources. The following directions will assist you in accessing the online platforms where all lessons and activities will be readily available. All correspondence and additional information regarding these resources will be provided through our district website and social media platforms.

**District Access to Resources:**

- Access the **PAISD** website ([www.paisd.org](http://www.paisd.org)).
- Click the **STUDENTS** tab at the top of the page
- Scroll down to **LEARNING APPS** (the last on the list) and click the tab
- You now have access to all online learning platforms available to you and your student. Below is a list that the team has used to plan for lessons each week.
- All students have login access to apps listed below:
  
- **Elementary Students**
  - **Imagine Math:** Pre-K to 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will use Blue Print/Imagine Math. This math program follows a specific grade level pathway that is aligned with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Students in Pre-K to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will work in the program for 20 minutes per week. Grades 3 – 5 will complete 1 lesson per week.
