## STEAM

Kindergarten students had a great time building chairs for Baby Bear's, using tangram blocks to build a castle for Cinderella, and building each of the three little pigs houses to see which could withstand the Wolf's huffing and puffing, along with making parachute's for Jack to escape from the Giant.

Using fairytales, we identified problems, brainstormed ideas, and built and tested different solutions to the problems.

In October we will be building mini hovercrafts, making weight-bearing spider webs, and making David's slingshot pouch.

## Art

October is *Children in Art Month*. We will learn why parents from long ago would commission artists to paint portraits of their children. We will compare the difference between modern day portrait painting with that of long time ago.

The class will continue to learn and recognize primary and secondary colors. They will do finger painting to explore how mixing primary colors they can get the secondary colors.

## Technology

This month in Technology the Toddler class will learn about mouse skills. Students will learn how to move their mouse, how to keep their mouse on their mousepad, and how to left click. They will use their mouse skills to open Photo Booth and take their own picture with a variety of fun filters.
