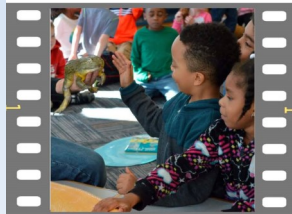

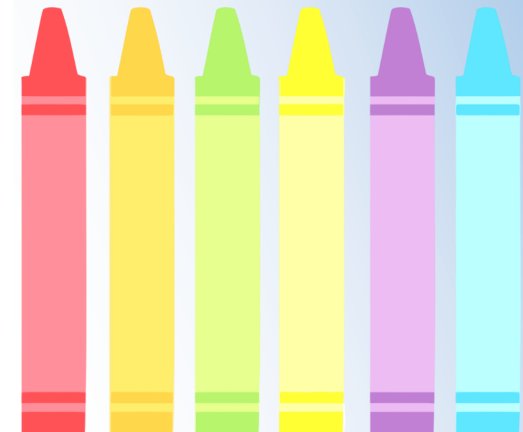

## Registering Your Child for Kindergarten

Children must be five years of age or older on September 1, 2019 to enroll in kindergarten for the 2019-20 school year.

## What should I bring to registration?

Please bring your completed registration forms along with the following papers. Original documents are required at the time of registration. All originals will be photo copied and returned to you as you register.

- **CERTIFIED BIRTH CERTIFICATE** for your child. It must be validated by the County Clerk. Hospital certificates are not official.
- **CUSTODY DOCUMENTATION** if applicable. Divorce decree, current form 906 from the Department of Children and Family Services, guardianship documents or other affidavits of custody.
- **CURRENT I.E.P.** or 504 PLAN if applicable.
- **HEALTH FORMS** are required. Completed physical, dental, and eye examinations need to be submitted to the school nurse before the first day of school. Children will not be allowed to start school without the completed forms and required immunizations.

## Proving Residency

In addition, proof of residency is required. All items must be current and reflect accurate name and address information.

- **VALID ILLINOIS DRIVER'S LICENSE** or **STATE OF ILLINOIS ID CARD**
- **MORTGAGE** or **LEASE** - If you own, bring in a current mortgage statement dated within the last two months. If you rent, bring in your current lease showing the date of expiration, and the name, address, and phone number of your landlord. A new lease must be provided each year or when the current lease expires. If you live with a District 153 resident, a notarized document and additional forms of identification may be required.
- **ONE (1) OF THESE ITEMS, SHOWING A CURRENT DATE:**
  - Utility bill: water, gas, or electric (telephone and cable bills are not accepted)
  - Homeowner's or Renter's insurance policy
