THANK YOU to all of the Mystery Readers that came in and read to the elementary students during the month of February! The students LOVED Mystery Reader Month!!!


THANK YOU to everyone who joined us for K-3 Muffin Morning on Friday, March 1st. We had a GREAT time celebrating Read Across America Day!

THANK YOU to the 5th/6th grade Science Fair volunteer judges and to all the families who came and looked at the projects. The students did an AMAZING job!


MCA TESTING
