



# Pathfinder Ranch 6th Grade Overnight Field Trip

## Timeline:

September 24, 2018 (Monday)

Indicate chaperone interest – Pathfinder limits the number of adults who can attend this trip. A limited number of male and female parents will be chosen from a random drawing to attend. Please note that you **MUST** be a TVCS approved driver to be a chaperone. A form will be sent home prior to this date for you to fill out if you are interested. Please return that form by September 24th to be considered.

Chaperones are valuable assets to the trip but have expected duties while on this overnight. Chaperones will need to help the following:

- Help students get to where they need to go on time
- Help supervise behavior in classes
- Supervise behavior and cleanliness in cabins
- Monitor eating and meal cleanup
- Supervise free-time

Required TVCS approved driver packets must be complete, including Live Scan results. Deposit due - \$105 for student / \$80 for chaperones

December 3, 2018 (Monday)

Balance due - \$100 / \$43 for chaperones
