## Northwest Elementary Campus Dress Code

**All pre-kindergarten –sixth grade students will wear a navy blue polo-style shirt (with a collar).**

- a) T-shirts are not allowed as an outer garment and long sleeve shirts are not to be worn underneath.
- b) Hoodie jackets are strictly forbidden.
- c) Boys are required to have their shirts tucked in at all times.

**All pre-kindergarten –sixth grade students will wear khaki pants or shorts (not jeans) that are in good condition.** Good condition is defined as: clean, without holes, rips, or tatters. Boys must wear a belt. In addition, female students may wear skirts or shorts as long as they are appropriate in length. Appropriate length is defined as: the material must reach the fingertips of the female student when their hands are by their side.

- a) Girls may wear leggings under appropriate length skirts, skorts or shorts.
- b) Pajama bottoms and cargo pants are not allowed.
- c) Sagging pants are not allowed.
- d) Articles of clothing, jewelry, backpacks, notebooks or other personal property promoting drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, sex, gangs, or other topics deemed inappropriate by school officials will not be worn or brought to school. These items will be confiscated and will not be returned.

**Jackets and sweaters may be worn during the cold season only. Both must be Navy Blue in color. A SWPREP Patch will need to be ironed on to all sweaters that are worn at school.**

**The following is important to know:**

- a) Hats, Du-rags, beanies or skull caps are not to be worn in the building.
- b) A maximum of one pair of visible piercings will be allowed.
- c) Unnatural hair colors such as blue, green, punk red or orange etc. are not allowed.

**Fundraising Fridays-** Students may wear jeans on Fridays if they choose to participate in the fundraising event (\$1). The student paying (\$1) may wear jeans of any color that follow the dress code guidelines. This means shorts, skirts, skorts, or shorts must be appropriate length and in good condition. Students that wear jeans and do not pay their (\$1) will lose the privilege to wear jeans for the year.

**Our campus will have several “dress in character” days.** These days allow the students to be out of dress code to express their creative side and individuality. There is not a charge to partake in these fun days. We highly encourage your child to participate on these days. Students that do not participate **MUST** be in uniform.

If a student chooses not to comply with the campus dress code, a parent/guardian will be contacted to bring appropriate items. The student will be removed from the class until corrected. Repeated violations will be considered persistent misbehavior and could result in a referral for disciplinary action.
