## ADVANCED PLACEMENT and DUAL ENROLLMENT CONTRACT

Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment courses are extremely challenging and are equivalent to an introductory (first year) college-level course. Courses are taught using college level materials and strategies in order to prepare students for college-level course work in addition to completing the College Board Advanced Placement Examinations in May. As a result, students should expect the pace and rigor of AP and Dual Enrollment courses to be more challenging than regular classes at the same grade level. These classes are intended for students who have demonstrated both the highest level of academic achievement as well as commitment to hard work. Students must consider the amount of time they are able and willing to commit to the study and preparation necessary for success.

**Prior to enrolling in an AP and Dual Enrollment course, students must agree to the following:**

- commit to academic excellence;
- complete any required summer assignments before the first day of class;
- attend class regularly and obtain missed assignments for approved absences;
- complete all assignments in order to improve reading, writing, reasoning, and critical thinking skills as well as to understand course content;
- organize time and study habits to successfully complete the course;
- commit at least one and a half hours of study time outside of class for each hour spent in the class; and talk with the teacher and take immediate action to prevent falling behind.
- Student **Must** attend 6 AP Readiness Workshops at UCR
- Student **Must** attend **mandatory tutoring** if has a grade of "C" or lower

**Prior to enrolling in an AP and Dual Enrollment courses Parents/Guardians agree to the following:**

- become familiar with the course requirements and withdrawal procedures;
- help organize study time in a location that is quiet and free from distractions; and
- contact the teacher immediately should his/her student struggle and begin to fall behind in class.

**Withdrawal Procedure:**

- during the first semester, students may withdraw from an AP or Dual Enrollment course during the first two (2) weeks of class. After this time, students must complete the entire first semester before requests to withdraw from the course will be considered. During the second semester, student requests to withdraw from an AP or Dual Enrollment course must be completed no later than the end of the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) day.
- parent, administrator, counselor and teacher approval are all required to withdraw from any AP or Dual Enrollment course.
- transfer grades for work completed will be provided.

I understand that the rigor of an AP and Dual Enrollment course are equivalent to a typical college course. Further, I understand that after the first semester or after the 5<sup>th</sup> day during the second semester, I will NOT be allowed to drop any course. I also agree to do everything in my power to be successful in the class.
