

ELEMENTARY REMOTE LEARNING PLAN OVERVIEW

PreK and Kindergarten

Teachers have prepared packets of assignments for students to complete at home. These packets cover 5 days of distance learning. Parents were invited to pick up the packets for students who were absent on 3/13 on Monday, March 16. Any parent who was unable to pick up their child's packet will find it in the drop box outside Lincoln School. Beginning the week of March 23 teachers will provide learning experiences for students through email or on their websites. Attendance will be taken via Google Docs for each teacher.

Grades 1-5

Daily plans of activities to complete will be provided in each subject, totaling about 2 hours per day. Instructional assignments may include traditional materials (paper/pencil) and online platforms. Special subjects teachers (i.e., physical education, library, art, music, Spanish) will provide learning experiences as well.

Virtual Office Hours

Teachers will advise parents of their "Office Hours", a four-hour window of time, where they will be available via email each day to answer questions and provide support as needed. Times are noted on teacher websites. It is expected that students will be working on assignments each school day when they are at home.

Attendance

Completion and submission of instructional activities will allow teachers to take student attendance.
