Legislative Session [The Clark County School District](#) (CCSD) Board of School Trustees approved a [legislative platform](#) in November aimed at providing rich and rigorous instruction, improving teaching and learning conditions, and ensuring efficient operations and finance.

Governor Sisolak and legislative leaders supported many of our legislative priorities with the ambitious goals outlined in the [Focus: 2024 strategic plan](#).

Pupil-Centered Funding Formula – SB543 [Historic legislation was passed in the 2019 Legislature to modernize Nevada's funding formula for the first time in more than 50 years.](#) Nevada had the oldest funding formula in the nation. This update is crucial as we work to accelerate student achievement and move toward adequate funding throughout Nevada. While no legislation is perfect, SB543 addresses most of our concerns with the old Nevada Plan. This formula:

- Is more transparent about where the money goes.
- Protects money set aside for education to make sure it stays with education.
- Implements a modernized, student-centered weighted funding formula
- Allows the district to maintain a two-month ending fund balance

Budget CCSD estimates it will receive approximately \$154.4 million more in the 2019-20 school year from the State. The District estimates it will receive a total of \$89.7 million more in 2020-21 than in 2019-20 from these same sources. It should also be noted that there are still a number of unknowns in these estimates such as actual enrollment, charter school enrollment in Clark County, the per-pupil amount of the Special Education DSA, and Class Size Reduction funding specific to the District.

[This document](#) summarizes the total the district needs in the upcoming two years of the biennium and has been utilizing these estimates since May 10, 2019. The district will announce what costs need to be reduced for the 2019-20 school year in June 2019.

Registration for 2019-2020 School Year Is Now Open

[Online registration](#) for Clark County School District (CCSD) students for the 2019-2020 school year is now open. Parents should note that the 2019-20 school year will begin on Aug. 12, 2019.

Families new to CCSD may begin their registration process online via register.ccsd.net. Families with currently enrolled students can complete registration using Parent Portal via Infinite Campus (campusportal.ccsd.net). The process will take less than five minutes for existing CCSD households.


Parents or guardians who already have an Infinite Campus account will see an announcement through the Parent Portal and a link connecting them to the 2019-20 registration page.

Schools will provide access to computers for parents to use for registration. CCSD urges all parents to register and enroll their students by the first day of class, due to the funding methods used by the state of Nevada.
