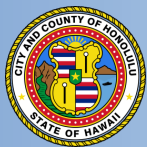

### OUR GOALS

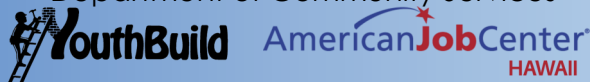
To eliminate or minimize barriers so young people can enter the workforce;

## Who Is Eligible

Eligible participants must be 16 to 24 years of age and fall within one or more of the following categories:

- Individual with a Disability
- Basic Skills Deficient
- English as a Second Language Learner
- Non-High School Graduate
- Didn't attend high school last quarter
- Offender
- Child of an incarcerated parent
- Experiencing homelessness or runaway
- Foster child
- Pregnant or parenting
- A low-income individual who requires additional assistance to complete their education or secure employment
